How a small monthly gift can make a big difference

Every year, KEMP Hospice helps hundreds of families in our community whose lives are affected by a life limiting illness.

This invaluable work is almost exclusively funded by the generous support we get from our local community and one of the best ways to support KEMP Hospice is by setting-up a regular gift to the hospice.

Regular gifts not only help to fund the hospice's work but they also help the hospice to plan our future care with a little more confidence.

Regular gifts also enable you to make a difference in a way that fits in with your personal budget; you can increase, decrease or cancel your regular gift at any time. What's more, if you are a UK Taxpayer, your regular gift is eligible for 'Gift Aid', which means your donation could be worth up to 25% extra at no additional cost to you.



The Day Hospice provides invaluable care and support to both patients and their carers.

When a patient is unable to access the Day Hospice, our Hospice at Home staff take our care and support out to people's homes, providing care whenever and wherever it is needed most.

1. If your declaration covers donations you may make in the future, please notify the charity if you change your name or address whilst the declaration is still in force. You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying the charity – it will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify.
2. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax the charity reclaim on your donations in the tax year.
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax the charity reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1).
4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief on your Self Assessment Tax Return.
5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, you can ask your local tax office for leaflet R113 Gift Aid.

£2

£25
